48 count, 2 wall, Beginner/Intermediate level
Choreographer : The Girls (Maureen & Michelle)
(UK) Nov 2001
Choreographed to : Do Wah Diddy ... by DJ Otzi
(CD Single) (136 bpm)

Start dance 16 counts after the guitar starts to play. (Clap hands and sing along with 'Do Wah Diddy Diddy Dum Diddy Do' while waiting to start.)

STEP, SCUFF, SHUFFLE, STEP, SCUFF, SHUFFLE

- 1-2 Step forward on right, scuff left forward
- 3&4 Shuffle forward stepping left, right, left
- 5-8 Repeat counts 1-4

WALKS BACK, GALLOP BACK, HOLD, OUT-OUT, CLAP

- 9-10 Walk back on right, left
- 11& Step back on right, step left beside right
- 12& Step back on right, step left beside right
- 13-14 Step back on right, hold
- &15-16 Step left to left, step right to right, clap (transfer weight to left)

ROCK, ½ TURN SHUFFLE, ROCK, COASTER

- 17-18 Rock forward on right, recover back on left
- 19&20 Making ½ turn right shuffle on right, left, right
- 21-22 Rock forward on left, recover back on right
- 23&24 Step back on left, step right beside left, step left forward
(Coaster step during counts 23&24 can be replaced with a triple step full turn to left)

WALKS, GALLOP FORWARD, HOLD, OUT-OUT, CLAP

- 25-26 Walk forward on right, left
- 27& Step forward on right, step left beside right
- 28& Step forward on right, step left beside right
- 29-30 Step forward on right, hold
- &31-32 Step left to left, step right to right, clap (transfer weight to left)

SAILOR STEPS, CHARLESTON KICK

- 33&34 Step right behind left, step left to left, step right to right
- 35&36 Step left behind right, step right to right, step left to left and slightly forward
- 37-38 Step right forward, kick left forward
- 39-40 Step back on left, touch right back

STEP, ½ PIVOT, STEP, HOLD, SHUFFLE, STEP ½ PIVOT

- 41-42 Step right forward, pivot ½ turn left
- 43-44 Step right forward, hold
- 45&46 Shuffle forward on left, right, left
- 47-48 Step forward on right, pivot ½ turn left
