Right Grapevine, Hitch, Left Grapevine, Turn & Hitch

- 1-2 Step right to right side, step left behind right
- 3-4 Step right to right side., hitch left knee up
- 5-6 Step left to left side. step right behind le7-8 Step on left making 1/4turn left, Hitch right
- To Stop of for making 17 real fort, the first

Right Grapevine, Hitch Left, Grapevine turn & Hitch

- 9-10 Step right to right side, step left behind right
- 11-12 Step right to right side., hitch left knee up
- 13-14 Step left forward & across right. step right back & behind left
- 15-16 Step on left making 1/4 turn left, Hitch right

Rock Forward in place, Rock Back in place, Stomp forward Right, Hold, Stomp

- 17-18 Step forward on right, replace weight back onto left
- 19-20 Step back on right, replace weight forward onto left
- 21-22 Stomp right forward HOLD & Clap
- 22-24 Stomp left forward HOLD & Clap

Reverse Rumba Box

- 25-26 Step right to right side. Close left next to right.
- 27-28 Step right back & HOLD
- 29-30 Step left to left side, Close right next to left
- 31-32 Step left forward & HOLD
