Section 1	Step Brush x 2, Jazz Box 1/4 Turn Right		
1 – 2	Step right forward. Brush left across right.	Step Brush	Forward
3 – 4	Step left forward. Brush right across left.	Step Brush	
5 – 6	Cross right over left. Step left back.	Cross Back	Back
7 – 8	Make 1/4 turn right and step right to side. Step left beside right. (3:00)	Turn Together	Turning right
