

Start on vocals

Side Rock Return, L Sailor, R Sailor, L Sailor

- 1,2 Rock/step L to left, Rock/return wt sideways onto R
3&4 Step L behind R, Step R slightly right, Step L slightly left (sailor step)
5&6 Step R behind L, Step L slightly left, Step R slightly right (sailor step)
7&8 Step L behind R, Step R slightly right, Step L slightly left (sailor step)

Rock/Return, Side Shuffle, Rock Return, Side Shuffle

- 9,10 Rock/step R behind L, Rock/return wt to L
11&12 Side/shuffle to the right R,L,R
13,14 Rock/step L behind R, Rock/return wt to R
15&16 Side/shuffle to the left L,R,L

Rock Return, 1/2 Turn Shuffle Fwd, Rock Return, Shuffle Fwd

- 17,18 Rock/step back on R, Rock fwd on L
19&20 Shuffle fwd R,L,R making 1/2 turn left
21,22 Rock/step back on L, Rock fwd on R
23&24 Shuffle fwd L,R,L

Rock Return, Step Back Touch, Bump Hips L,R,L,R

- 25,26 Rock/step fwd on R, Rock back on L
27,28 Step back on R, Touch L beside R
29-32 Bump hips L,R,L,R

This dance introduces Sailor Steps and offers more practice for Shuffles, Side Shuffles and Turning Shuffles.

It is the 15th dance from the series of 20 Beginner Dances which can be found on the cd 'Dances For Beginners Volume 2'.

The song by Alan Jackson has been around for years, but if you are new to line dancing you may not have heard it before. It's a beautiful song and feels very nice to dance to. Hope you enjoy it too.
