- 3-4 Step forward right, touch left toe behind right heel
- 5-6 Step back left, lock right in front
- 7-8 Step back left, touch right toe in front of left foot

## MONTEREY TURN, GRAPEVINE LEFT, SCUFF

- 9 Touch right toe out to right side
- On ball of left pivot ½ turn right, stepping right beside left
- 11-12 Touch left toe out to left side, touch left next to right
- 13-14 Step left to left side, cross right behind left
- 15-16 Step left to left, scuff right

#### 2 X TOE STRUTS, SLOW COASTER STEP, HOLD, TWICE

- 17-18 Step right toe forward, drop right heel taking weight
- 19-20 Step left toe forward, drop left heel taking weight
- 21-23 Step right foot back, step left next to right, step forward right
- 24 Hold
- 25-26 Step left toe forward, drop left heel taking weight
- 27-28 Step right toe forward, drop right heel taking weight
- 29-31 Step left foot back, step right next to left, step left forward
- 32 Hold

### **TOE POINTS, MONTEREY TURN**

- 33-34 Touch right toe out to right side, step right in place
- 35-36 Touch left toe out to left side, step left in place
- 37 Touch right toe out to right side
- 38 On ball of left pivot ½ turn right, stepping right beside left
- 39-40 Touch left toe out to left side, step left in place

## TOE POINTS, JAZZ BOX WITH 1/4 TURN

- 41-42 Touch right toe out to right side, step right in place
- 43-44 Touch left toe out to left side, step left in place
- 45-46 Cross right over left, step back left
- 47-48 Step right ¼ turn to right, step left in place

The dance finishes on Count 16 after the left grapevine. The track ends with the band playing a final flourish, during which time you can take a bow, do a twirl, throw your Stetson in the air, whatever you like – just enjoy!
