STEPS	ACTUAL FOOTWORK	CALLING SUGGESTION	DIRECTION
Section 1 1 – 3 4 – 5 6 7 – 12	Crossing Twinkle Steps With 1/2 Turn Right (x 2) Cross left over right. Step right to right side. Step left to left side. Cross right over left. Step left beside right making 1/4 turn right. Make 1/4 turn right stepping right to right side. Repeat counts 1 – 6.	Cross 2 3 Cross Turn Turn	Right Turning right
Section 2 1 – 3 4 – 6 7 – 9 10 – 12 Note	Cross Rock Side (x 3) Grapevine Cross rock left over right. Recover onto right. Step left to left side. Cross rock right over left. Recover onto left. Step right to right side. Cross rock left over right. Recover onto right. Step left to left side. Cross right over left. Step left to left side.
