

My Sweet Gypsy Rose

64 count, 2 wall, beginner/intermediate level

Choreographer: Chee Kiang Lim (Singapore)

Feb 2006

Choreographed to: Say Has Anybody Seen My Sweet Gypsy Rose by Tony Orlando and Dawn (170 bpm)

Intro: After 1st heavy beat, approximately 35 seconds into song

TOE STRUTS (X2), ROCKING CHAIR, TOUCH

1-4 R toe strut, L toe strut

5-7 Rock R forward, recover on L, step and lean back on R

8 Touch L in front of R

(Styling : On count 8, put both hands behind the ears and shout "Hey")

TOE STRUTS (X2), ROCKING CHAIR, TOUCH

1-4 L toe strut, R toe strut

5-7 Rock L forward, recover on R, step and lean back on L

8 Touch R in front of L

(Styling : On count 8, put both hands behind the ears and shout "Hey")

SHUFFLE RIGHT, BACK ROCK, SHUFFLE LEFT, BACK ROCK

1&2 Shuffle to right (R, L, R)

3-4 Rock L behind R, recover on R

5&6 Shuffle to left (L, R, L)

7-8 Rock R behind L, recover on L

QUARTER MONTERY TURN (X2)

1-2 Point R to right, turn 1/4 right, step R besides L

3-4 Point L to left, step L besides R

5-8 Repeat step 1-4

FORWARD DIAGONAL LOCK STEPS (X2)

1-4 Step R diagonally forward, lock L behind R, step R diagonally forward, hold

5-8 Step L diagonally forward, lock R behind L, step L diagonally forward, hold

(Styling : Push hands up, down, up – first to right (1-4), then to left (5-8))

RUNNING BACK, STEP HITCH (X2)

1-4 Run back (R, L, R, L)

5-6 Step R to right, hitch L (look left)

7-8 Step L to left, hitch R (look right)

VINE WITH QUARTER TURN (X2)

1-2 Step R to right, step L behind R,

3-4 Turn 1/4 right, step R to right, step L forward

5-8 Repeat steps 1-4

CHARLESTON STEPS (X2)

1-2 Sweep R forward, hold

3-4 Step back on R, hold

5-6 Sweep L back, hold

7-8 Step forward on L, hold

(Styling : Rotate hands clockwise, then counter clockwise, twice)

TAG

1&2 Shuffle to right.

3-4 Back rock on L

5&6 Shuffle to left

7-8 Back rock on R

RESTARTS:

On wall 3, dance to step 32, add TAG and restarts

On wall 6, dance to step 16, and restarts

PUT ON A BIG SMILE :) :) :) WHEN YOU DANCE !
