32 Count, 2 Wall, Beginner Choreographer: Tony Wilson (USA) Feb 2013 Choreographed to: I Ain't Goin' Peacefully by Hank Williams Jr., (122 bpm), CD: The Nashville Collection; Saying Sorry by Borderers (116bpm), CD: Inspired; Some Kind of Trouble by Tanya Tucker (120 bpm) CD: The Most Awesome Line Dance Album 5; Rockin' Rodeo by Asleep At The Wheel (130 bpm), CD: The Wheel Keeps On Rollin'; Teach: I Thought There Was Time by Blake Shelton, (96 bpm), CD: Blake Shelton

FORWARD RLR DIG, BACK RLR TOUCH

- 1-2 Step R forward, step L forward
- 3-4 Step R forward, dig L heel forward
- 5-6 Step L back, step R back
- 7-8 Step L back, touch R toe next to L

VINE WITH DIG, VINE WITH TOUCH

- 9-10 Step R side right, step L behind R
- 11-12 Step Right to right side, dig L heel forward
- 13-14 Step L to left side, step R behind L
- 15-16 Step L to side, touch R toe next to L

1/4 TURN x2, JAZZ BOX

- 17-18 Step R forward, turn 1/4 left stepping L in place
- 19-20 Step R forward, turn 1/4 left stepping L in place
- 21-22 Cross R over L, step back on L
- 23-24 Step R back and to side, step L next to R

HEEL TAPS HOLD, COASTER HOLD

- 25-26 Tap Right heel forward, R step next to L
- 27-28 Tap L heel forward, hold
- 29-30 Step L back, step R next to L
- 31-32 Step L forward, hold
- (Optional claps on hold counts)
