

Pickin' Peaches

24 Count, 4 Wall, Improver

Choreographer: Pas Esper (USA) Jan 2012

Choreographed to: Georgia Peaches by Lauren Alaina

Phrase map: 24-24-16(restart)-24-24-24-16(restart)-24-24-20(restart)-24-24-24-10(song ends)

Kick-ball-point, Kick-ball-point, 360 degree paddle turn

- 1&2. Kick left foot forward, Step onto the ball of left foot, Point right toe to the side.
- 3&4. Kick right foot forward, Step onto the ball of right foot, Point left toe to the side.
- 5&. Turn a 1/4 turn to right, Touch left toes to the side.
- 6&. Turn a 1/4 turn to right, Touch left toes to the side.
- 7&. Turn a 1/4 turn to right, Touch left toes to the side.
- 8&. Turn a 1/4 turn to right, Touch left toes to the side.

Modified jazz triangle cross, Side, Skate, Skate, syncopated cross rock recover side.

- 9. Cross left foot over right.
- 10. Step back on right foot.
- &11. Step left foot next to right, Cross right foot over left.
- 12. Step left foot to the side.
- 13. Push right foot forward and diagonally to right.
- 14. Push left foot forward and diagonally to left.
- 15&16. Rock right foot over left, Recover onto left foot, step right foot to the side.

Syncopated cross rock recover turn, shuffle forward, Rock, Recover, Together, Heel twist

- 17&18. Rock left foot over right, Recover onto right foot, Turn 1/4 turn to left stepping forward on left foot
- 19&20. Step forward on right foot, Step left foot next to right, Step forward on right foot.
- 21. Rock forward on left foot.
- 22. Recover onto right foot.
- 23. Step left foot next to right.
- &24. Turn both heel to left, Bring both heels to center.

Restarts: There are 3 restarts that can be done to stay with the phrasing of the song; however, it is optional to do the restarts. The floor leader can determine if they are done or not.

The restarts happen: 16 counts after the full second wall,
16 counts after the full fifth wall
20 counts after the full seventh wall.

Ending: If you like to end facing the starting wall, during the last 10 counts of the song, instead of making 1/4 turns on counts 5 thru 8, lower it to eighth turns.
