

Pogo Johnny

36 count, 4 wall, beginner/intermediate level
Choreographer: Lesley Ellen (UK) Sept 2004
Choreographed to: Johnny Come Lately by Steve Earle & The Pogues; Sweet Home Alabama by Lynard Skynard; Battle Of New Orleans by Johnny Horton

Intro: 16 from the vocal 'when I first got to London it was pouring with rain'

1&2 Split heels, heels together, R hook over L shin
& R step beside L
3&4 Split heels, heels together, L hook over R shin
& L step beside R
5&6& Swivel heels out, swivel toes out, swivel heels out, hold
7&8& Swivel heels in, swivel toes in, swivel heels in, hold

9&10 R step fwd, L lock behind R, R step fwd
& Scuff L passed R

11&12& L rock fwd, R step back, L step back making ¼ turn left, hold
13&14& R step across L, L step left, R step behind L, L step left
15&16& R step across L, L step left, R touch beside L, hold

17& R touch to right, R step behind L
18& L touch to left, L step behind R
19& R touch to right, R step behind L
20& L touch to left, hold

21&22 L step across R, bounce heels twice as you unwind ½ turn right
23&24 R step back, L step beside R, R step fwd
25&26 L step in front of R, split heels out-in
27&28& R step fwd, clap, L step fwd, clap

29&30 R step in front of L, split heels out-in
31&32& L step fwd, clap, R step fwd, clap
33&34 L rock fwd, R step back, L step back making ½ turn left
& R step beside L
35,36& L step fwd, R step fwd, L step beside R

** If using the Battle Of New Orleans track by Johnny Horton:**

In order that the dance phrases in correctly with this track:-

ON WALL 3: After counts 15&16& there is 1 extra beat: Hook R over L shin then carry on from count 17&

ON WALL 4: Dance the first 24 counts, then step L next to R on the & count and

RESTART the dance again from the beginning
