Raindrops For Perfidia

32 Count 4 Walls Intermediate Level
Choreographed by:Forty Arroyo (USA) 2005
Choreographed to:Perfidia by John Altman
Shall We Dance Soundtrack CD
24 Count Intro.

Sequence: 32, 32, 32,16, 32, 32, 32.....to end.

Section 1 SIDE, TOGETHER, FORWARD, HOLD, SIDE, TOGETHER, FORWARD, HOLD

1-4 Step R to R side, Step L together, Step forward on R, Hold

5-8 Step L to L side, Step R together. Step forward on L, Hold

Section 2 SIDE, TOGETHER, BACK, HOLD, SIDE, TOGETHER, BACK HOLD

9-12 Step R to R side, Step L together, Step back on R, Hold

13-16 Step L to L side, Step R together, Step back on L, Hold (end at 12 o'clock)

Section 3 WALK BACK R, L, R, LOW KICK, ROCK BACK, RECOVER, STEP, PIVOT ½ R

1-4 Walk back R, L, R, Low kick L forward

5-8 Rock back on L, Recover on R, Step forward on L, Pivot ½ turn to R (end at 6 o'clock)

Section 4 TWO FULL TURNS TO R (OPTIONAL), ROCK, RECOVER, STEP BACK, SLIDE TOUCH

1- 2 Step forward on L turning ½ R, (1) Step back on R turning ½ R (2)

3 - 4 REPEAT FOR COUNTS 3-4

(Beginner easy option: If you are not a spinner - step forward Left, Hold, Step forward Right, hold.

5 - 8 Rock forward on L, Recover on R, Big step back on L, Slide and touch R next to L (end at 6 o'clock) &

Pivot ¼ to Right on Left foot.

The fourth time you start the dance, do only the first 16 counts, then restart – the music will guide you.

Ending – you will be ending your last rotation at 6 o'clock – Pivot ½ on ball of LF (crossing arms at hips level) and Step Right forward to 12 o'clock (extending arms out to side – palms up)

Raindrops For Perfidia was inspired by Louie St George when he suggested the music "Perfidia" for the dance "Raindrops" which was choreographed (by me) to "Raindrops" by Dee Clark. Although many prefer Perfidia, it was not a perfect fit. So "Raindrops For Perfidia" was born; I preserved the first 32 counts of "Raindrops" and added a ½ count at the end turning ¼ to R. Now there's "Raindrops" to the song Raindrops by Dee Clark (perfectly phrased, 40 count dance with an 8 count tag – listed on kickit) and then there's. "Raindrops For Perfidia" a perfect fit to an awesome instrumental piece. Enjoy it and thank you Louie.
