STEPS	ACTUAL FOOTWORK	CALLING SUGGESTION	DIRECTION
Section 1	Forward Rock, Shuffle Back, Back Rock, Forward Shuffle		
1 – 2	Rock forward on right. Recover onto left.	Rock Forward	On the spot
3 & 4	Step right back. Close left beside right. Step right back.	Shuffle Back	Back
5 – 6	Rock back on left. Recover onto right.	Rock Back	On the spot
7 & 8	Step left forward. Close right beside left. Step left forward.	Left Shuffle	Forward
Section 2	Side Rock, Cross Shuffle, 1/4 Turn x 2, Forward Shuffle		
1 – 2	Rock right to right side. Recover onto left.	Side Rock	On the spot
3 & 4	Cross right over left. Step left to left side. Cross right over left.	Cross Shuffle	Left
5 – 6	Make 1/4 turn right stepping left back. Make 1/4 turn right stepping right to side.	Quarter Quarter	Turning right
7 & 8	Step left forward. Close right beside left. Step left forward.	Left Shuffle	Forward
Section 3	Point, Sweep, Behind Side Cross, Point, Sweep, Behind, 1/4 Turn, Together		
1 – 2	Point right toe forward. Sweep right round behind left.	Point Sweep	On the spot
3 & 4	Step right behind left. Step left to left side. Cross right over left.	Behind Side Cross	Left
5 – 6	Point left toe forward. Sweep left round behind right.	Point Sweep	On the spot
7 & 8	Step left behind right. Make 1/4 turn left stepping right forward. Step left beside right.	Behind Turn Together	Turning left
Section 4	Forward Rock, Coaster Step, Forward Rock, Triple 1/2 Turn		
1 – 2	Rock forward on right. Recover onto left.	Rock Forward	On the spot
3 & 4	Step right back. Step left beside right. Step right forward.	Coaster Step	
5 – 6	Rock forward on left. Recover onto right.	Rock Forward	
7 & 8	Triple step 1/2 turn left, stepping - left, right, left.	Triple Half Turn	Turning left
