Section 1	R Forward Step Together Step Hold, L Heel Toe
1-4	R Step Forward, L Next to R, R Step Forward, Hold
- 0	I II al Tara (Assaladat an Madat)

5-8 L Heel, Toe (weight on right)

Section 2 L Forward Step Together Step Hold, R Heel Toe 1-4 L Step Forward, R Next to L, L Step Forward, Hold

5-8 R Heel, Toe

Section 3 R Side Step Together Step Hold, Sway

1-4 R Step to Right Side, L Next to R, R Step to Right Side, Hold

5-8 Sway

Section 4 L Side Step Together Step Hold, Sway

1-4 L Step to Left Side, R Next to L, L Step to Left Side

5-8 Sway

**Section 5**1/2 Turn Right Walk R, L, R, L,
1-8
Turn 1/2 Right with Walks R, L, R, L

Fun Fact: Clyde McPhatter formed the group "Drifters". "A Lover's Question" was the most successful in his solo career. Elvis Presley recorded several of his songs.
