**Start:**            **With the begin of the singing part - No Tags No Restarts**

**Section 1        Toe Heel Stomp 2x, Rock Step, Triple Turn 1/2**

1&2            Touch right toe beside left, touch right heel beside left, stomp right beside left  
3&4            Touch left toe beside right, touch left heel beside right, stomp left beside right  
5-6            Rock fwd on right, recover on left  
7&8            1/4 right stepping right to right side , step left next to right 1/4 stepping fwd on right

**Section 2        Toe Heel Stomp 2x, Rock Step, Triple Turn 1/2**

1&2            Touch left toe beside right, touch left heel beside right, stomp left beside right  
3&4            Touch right toe beside left, touch right heel beside left, stomp right beside left  
5-6            Rock fwd on left, recover on right  
7&8            1/4 left stepping left to left side , step right next to left 1/4 stepping fwd on left

**Section 3        Triple Fwd, Step Turn Step, Triple Full Turn, Step Turn Cross 1/4**

1&2            Right fwd, left next to right, right fwd  
3&4            Step fwd on left, make 1/2 turn right on bales (weight back on right), step fwd on left  
5&6            1/2 turn with the right foot (over left ), 1/2 turn with the left foot (over left), step fwd with right  
7&8            Step fwd on left, make 1/4 turn tight on bales(weight back on right), cross left over right

**Section 4        Side Rock, Behind Side Cross, Rock Fwd., Coaster Step**

1-2            Rock right to right side, recover on left  
3&4            Cross right behind left, step left to left side, cross right over left  
5-6            Rock fwd on left recover on right  
7&8            Step back on left, step right next to left, step fwd on left

**The dance starts again. Just have fun.**
