

## A Waltz For Ann

48 count, 4 wall, beginner level

Choreographer: Andrew & Lynda Blackwood (NZ)

June 2007

Choreographed to: Annie's Song by John Denver

21 count intro

### 1 – 12 Diamond Waltz Steps

1-2-3 Step left forward on left diagonal turning  $\frac{1}{4}$  left, bring R beside L, close L (facing 9.00)

4-5-6 Step right back on right diagonal turning  $\frac{1}{4}$  left, bring L beside R, close R (facing 6.00)

7-8-9 Repeat steps 1-3 (now facing 3.00)

10-12 Repeat steps 4-6 (now facing 12.00)

### 13 – 24 Forward $\frac{1}{4}$ turn, back, forward $\frac{1}{2}$ turn, back

1-2-3 Stepping L foot forward with  $\frac{1}{4}$  turn to the left, bring R beside L, close L (facing 9.00)

4-5-6 Step back on R, bring L beside R, close L.

7-8-9 Stepping L foot forward with  $\frac{1}{4}$  turn to the left, step R back turning  $\frac{1}{4}$  left, close L (3.00)

10-12 Step back on R, bring L beside R, close R.

### 25 – 36 Twinkle, x2, Back touch x2

1-2-3 Cross L foot over R, step R to R, step L to L

4-5-6 Cross R foot over L, step L to L, step R to R

7-8-9 Step back on L behind R, point R to R, hold

10-11-12 Step back on R behind L, point L to L, hold

### 37 – 48 Cross. Turn, Turn, Rock Recover, Vine and Drag

1-2-3 Cross L over R, turn  $\frac{1}{4}$  left while stepping back on R, turning  $\frac{1}{4}$  left while stepping L to L

4-5-6 Cross R over L, recover weight back to L, step R to R

7-8-9 Cross L over R, step R to R, step L behind R

10-12 Large step R to R, drag L slowly to R, touch L beside R
